Re: TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ALONG THE HOLYPORT ROAD, HOYPORT

Thank you very much for your letter of 23 February 2007 regarding the above. Please accept our sincere apologies for the delay in responding to you.

We can appreciate the Parish Council's concerns regarding the issue of traffic speeds and its implications on road safety on Holyport Road and as you mentioned in your letter the Council has already implemented traffic measures on the road to improve the situation.

However we are unable to progress the Parish Council's suggestion of providing red strips and 30mph roundels at southern end of Holyport Road (near its junction with Cadogan Close) because the Government's 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002' do not allow the use of the 30mph roundels as repeaters on roads with street lighting. In other words a 30mph roundel cannot be used at the suggested location because the speed limit does not change at that location.

With the above in mind, we regret that it will not be possible to progress your suggestion. However please do not hesitate to contact me on the above telephone number, if you would like to discuss the matter further.
