**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME – HOLYPORT ROAD,  
MAIDENHEAD**

You will no doubt remember last year's consultation in respect of the potential introduction of traffic calming measures within Holyport Road. The analysis of the responses indicated that 92% were in favour of introducing these measures.

In respect of the preferred type of traffic calming the majority were in favour of speed cushions ideally with a pedestrian crossing. As a result of this response the Borough have carried out a survey and developed an outline design for the introduction of speed cushions. The survey results and our engineers did not conclude that a pedestrian crossing was suitable and the design is based on speed cushions as traffic calming measures and a copy of these proposals ( Drawing Nrs NPA-C-T-1478.DWG) is attached.

If you have any further comments or objections I would be grateful if you could let me have them in writing by 6<sup>th</sup> February 2003, so that they can be reported to the Lead Member for Traffic Management and Public Protection for a decision on whether to proceed.

Copies of this letter have been sent to the appropriate consultees, Parish, Borough and Ward members, together with other properties fronting the scheme.
